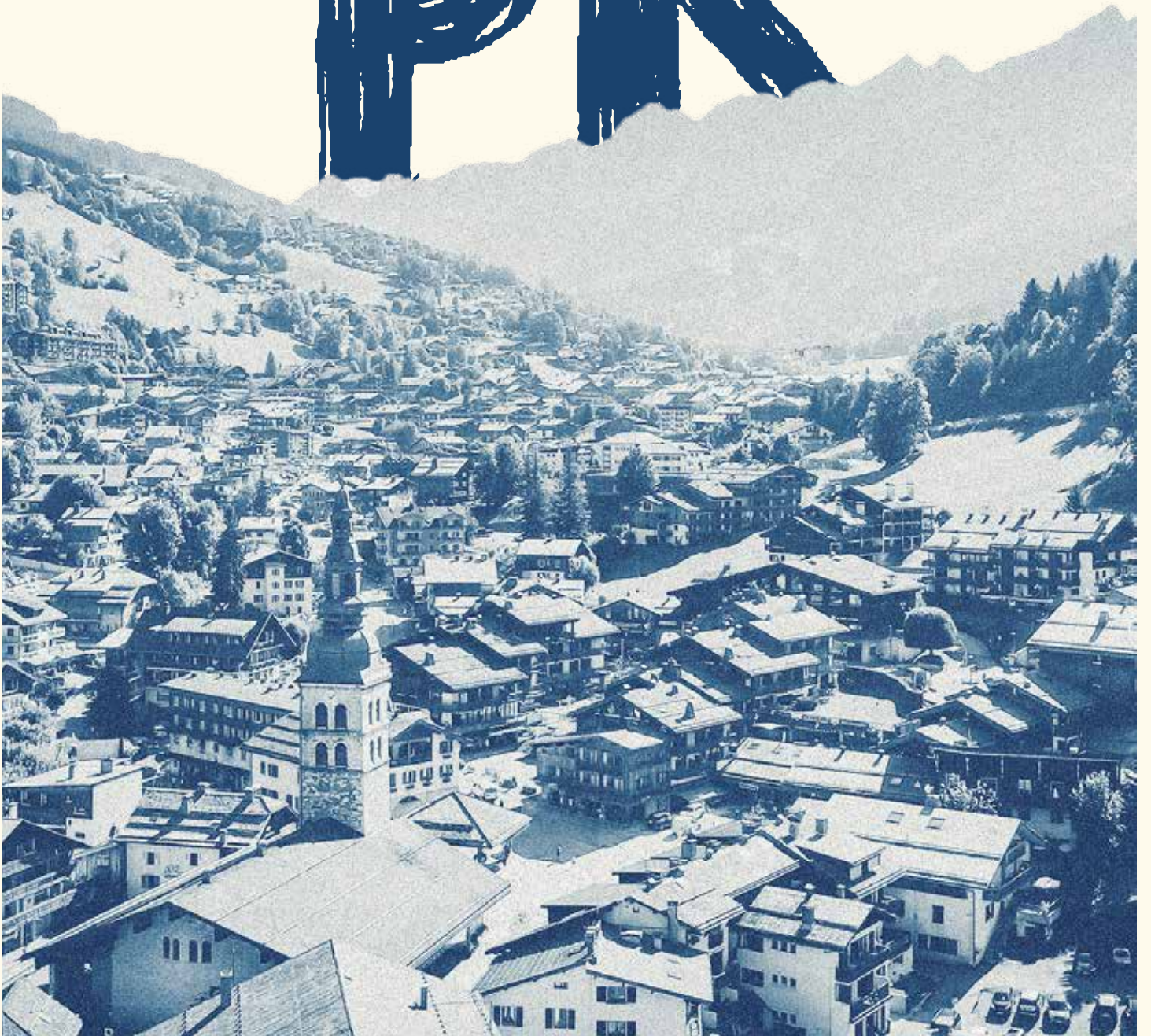

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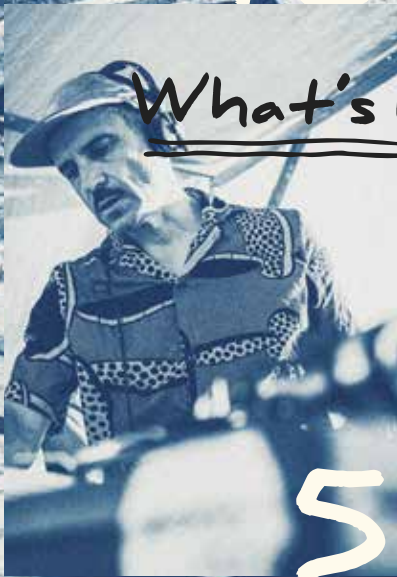

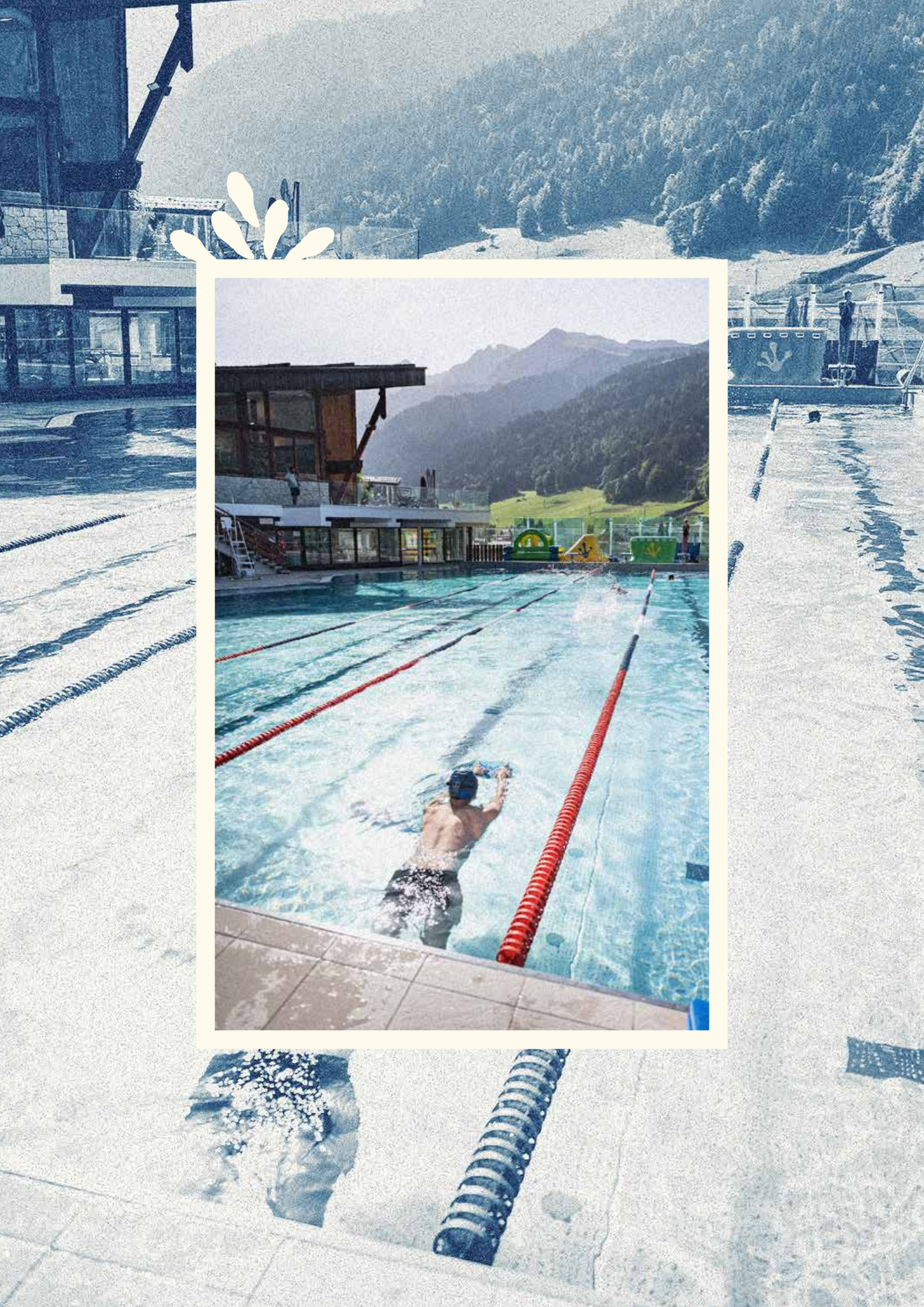

# What's new in the village

## La Clusaz Aquatic Center

### New features for Summer 2026

The Espace Aquatique de La Clusaz will exceptionally open as early as May 14, 2026, offering residents and visitors early and gradual access to its facilities. All summer long, swimming will be complemented by a wide range of activities: a water play area for young children, inflatable structures on Wednesday and Saturday afternoons, waterslides open late morning and in the afternoon, as well as aquagym, aquabike, and swimming lessons starting in June. Short swimming courses will also be available.

### Visitors will be able to enjoy the new facilities resulting from the renovation:

- Indoor and outdoor pools with bubble seats, neck fountains, massage jets, and a leisure pool
- improved accessibility for people with reduced mobility, including a lift and adapted wheelchair
- New indoor and outdoor paddling pools
- A slide area (CanonSlide and multi-lane slides)
- A sun deck and picnic area.

Not to forget the wellness area (sauna/steam room) and the fitness room.

A fully modernized facility with extended opening times to make the most of summer in La Clusaz.

## A vibrant summer community life for everyone

Complementing the activities of the Residents' House, cultural events open to all will be offered throughout the summer in the heart of the village. Each week, classical music concerts will take place at Église Sainte-Foy. These "hat concerts" are open to both music lovers and curious visitors alike.

The Refuge Tour (eco-friendly world music concerts) will stop in La Clusaz in July at the Jardin des Campanules. An open-air cinema will also be offered in August. Deck chairs, light food, and drinks will be available on site to fully enjoy these outdoor events.

## The Residents' House

A new living space in the heart of the village of La Clusaz, the Residents' House is a place for proximity, services, culture, and connection. It is an intergenerational hub welcoming all audiences, locals, seasonal workers, secondary residents, and visitors throughout the year.

A true resource center, it brings together the municipal post office, the library, and a multidisciplinary socio-cultural space. Visitors can enjoy temporary exhibitions, creative workshops, cultural activities, wellness sessions, themed evenings, screenings, social gatherings, and public service support desks. During the summer season, outdoor workshops will also be offered.

*Practical information: open Monday to Friday, with occasional weekend openings.*

## Anney Mountains App Your outdoor guide to Lake Anney and the Aravis region

This summer, a new app is launching: Lake Anney Aravis Outdoor. Designed for all nature and sports enthusiasts, it brings together in one place the most beautiful mountain bike, road cycling, and hiking routes around Anney, Les Sources du Lac, and the Massif des Aravis.

Intuitive and comprehensive, the app makes it easy to choose a route based on your level, your mood, or your preferred activity. Each itinerary includes key details such as distance, elevation gain, estimated time, points of interest, and practical tips. It also uses geolocation to suggest the nearest available routes.

Whether for a sporty outing, a family ride, or simply exploring the area, Lake Anney Aravis Outdoor becomes the perfect companion to fully enjoy this exceptional playground between lakes and mountains.

# What's new in activities

## **Creative workshop "Bélier qui cartonne", a hands-on activity focused on local wool**

"Bélier qui cartonne" returns in 2026! Every week at the Balcon des Aravis, La Clusaz offers a creative and educational workshop in partnership with the association Défrise ton mouton. The goal is to raise children's awareness of local wool from the Thônes et Marthod sheep breed, an iconic part of the region's heritage.

Participants transform a cardboard ram structure into a charming creation using real local sheep's wool. It's a hands-on, sensory, and educational experience that gently introduces key questions: why do we shear sheep? What happens to the wool afterwards? How can it be valued locally? All of this is done with humour, softness, and plenty of good old local wool.

*Practical information: weekly workshop at the Balcon des Aravis, for children aged 7 and over, under parental supervision.*

## **"Débaroule" trail, a free-flowing, intergenerational life-sized game**

Between the top of the La Patinoire gondola and Bossonnet, La Clusaz unveils a brand-new playful experience: Débaroule. Kids and adults alike are invited to send their wooden ball rolling down an easy hiking trail, punctuated with wooden structures, modules, and varied passages. No timing, no competition, no strict rules. A suggested route is marked on site to guide visitors, but everyone is free to play at their own pace, create their own paths, and even repeat the experience as many times as they like.

*Practical information: the game is open to all ages and free to access. Only the wooden ball is sold, priced at €5. The La Patinoire gondola is free of charge.*



## **La Luge des Bois: An exciting rail sled experience**

A new must-try summer experience in La Clusaz, La Luge des Bois invites both kids and adults to enjoy a fun downhill ride through the forest. This all-season rail sled track offers the perfect blend of fun and thrills, and is accessible in all weather conditions. Combining safety with sliding fun, La Luge des Bois lets riders control their speed throughout the descent, making it suitable for both children and adults.

*Sleds accommodate 1 to 2 people. Accessible from age 3, with independent use from 1.30 m in height. Price: €9 per ride. Open during the May bank holidays, every weekend in May and June, and continuously throughout the summer season, with evening sessions on Saturday nights.*

## **Mountain Kart, a fun downhill ride from the summit of Crêt du Loup**

Crêt du Loup welcomes the Mountain Kart, a new way to experience downhill mountain fun in summer. This three-wheeled, engine-free all-terrain kart is driven purely by gravity. Thanks to its integrated braking system, riders can fully control their speed, ensuring a ride that is both fun and safe. Its wide and stable design also makes it highly maneuverable, even for beginners.

The route follows the Dahu trail, starting from the summit of Crêt du Loup, covering 3.5 km along the 4x4 Dahu track. It offers a natural, scenic, and accessible descent.

*Activity accessible from age 13. Minimum height: 1.40 m. Departure point: top of the Crêt du Loup chairlift.*





## Must-do hikes in La Clusaz for a solo adventure

- Start your day right with an early-morning hike to Lac de Tardevant, when the light is soft and the mountains are still quiet.
- End it in style with a sunset at the top of Beaugard, where you can soak in sweeping views all the way to Mont Blanc.



# Unique experiences

## Wild plant discovery walk with Bota'Nico

In the alpine setting of Lac des Confins, at the foot of the Massif des Aravis, a morning introduction to wild plant discovery is offered to visitors. This guided foraging walk invites participants to explore local species on an educational botanical outing. Along the way, plants are observed up close to uncover their stories, traditional uses, and the close links they maintain with their mountain environment. The morning ends with a homemade, seasonal snack, naturally inspired by the plants discovered during the walk.

## Unique experiences

In an exceptional alpine setting at the heart of the Aravis mountain range, Les Confins, one of La Clusaz's most iconic sites, offers endless possibilities for hiking. With its open alpine pastures, gentle terrain and authentic atmosphere, it's the perfect place to breathe deeply and reconnect with nature. A variety of activities are available, including a 6-hole golf course with stunning views of the Danay mountain.

For an even more memorable experience with children, set off on a walk accompanied by a donkey or a pony, friendly, motivating trail companions offered by Les Galopins.

Throughout the summer, the La Clusaz Mountain Guides Office runs themed hikes designed to introduce kids to the joy of walking: discovering marmots, tracking chamois, or even stargazing hikes. They also offer beginner sessions in climbing and via ferrata.

## The Hameau des Alpes

La Clusaz is a true showcase of mountain heritage, and the Hameau des Alpes is one of its must-see cultural spots. In addition to guided tours of the village, the Hameau offers year-round interactive spaces: a dive into the world of Reblochon cheese, a ski museum, a traditional communal oven, old storage barns and a historic sawmill. It's the perfect place to explore the cultural richness and traditions that have shaped La Clusaz.

**For the little ones:** the "Hameau des Petits", Young children get their own dedicated time slot to explore nature and local heritage through playful workshops and hands-on activities inspired by life on the farm. In a warm and authentic setting, they can touch, taste, experiment and imitate the daily gestures of farmers. 1.5-hour sessions are offered each week, upon reservation.

## La Grange des Minis learning through play

For the second summer in a row, the life of the ice rink has completely transformed for the warm season. In an eco-responsible and sustainable approach, the rink will no longer be iced during summer. Instead, it once again becomes a playful space for children aged 0 to 8, welcoming little ones from the village and beyond. Five themed worlds are offered in this space, inviting young children to discover the mountain universe through sensory play, construction activities, and motor-skills courses. A fun and engaging way to inspire kids (and their parents) to explore, venture out, and connect with the nature and mountains around them.

**Prices:** €13 for children aged 2-12 / €4.50 for accompanying adults aged 13+ / family rate for 4 people: €28 / free for children under 2 / special rates available for visitors with disabilities. Location: at the Patinoire de La Clusaz Opening: from June 13, 2026 - 3 days a week, then daily from July onward.

And Thônes - La Clusaz will be right at the center of it all, sharing this extraordinary momentum with locals, visitors, and passionate riders alike.

With passionate instructors by your side, you'll work on the fundamentals of mountain biking: choosing the right line, handling obstacles, managing speed, and reading the terrain.

Schools such as Evolution 2 La Clusaz and Alpes Aventures offer sessions tailored to every level. Their goal: to teach solid techniques and build confidence so you can ride smoothly, comfortably, and with maximum enjoyment, while making the most of the alpine setting. Whether you're just starting out or aiming to refine your style, these sessions promise to turn every descent into a true moment of freedom.
